

WHY EDGEWISE?

EdgeWise Curbing's extruded concrete borders:

- Increase the Beauty of Your Property

 - Define gardens, flower beds and property lines

 - Customize color, shape, pattern and more
- Ease Your Yard Work Burden

 - Reduce time spent trimming edges the concrete is strong and stable enough to support the lawn mower wheel!
- Provide Permanent and Maintenance Free Edging

 - Will not decompose and rot like wood
 - Will not move like brick



First, Choose Your Shape:



Slant Style: The slant style mold is our most popular shape. The shape alone adds interest to a landscape; however, this shape allows the most options for stamps and textures.

Mower's Edge Style: Though both the slant and mower styles work well with a mower, the shape of the mower style is easier to mow around with a riding mower. Its shape allows you to place one wheel of your mower on the lower edge of the curb, which will greatly reduce the amount of "weed-eating" or edging required around beds or borders. While all of our color choices are available for the Mower's Edge, we do not stock stamps or rollers for this style; however they can be special ordered.





6x4 Style: This style provides heavier curbing for more practical applications such as edging driveways, horseshoe pits or walkways. The top of this curb can be textured and we have some stamp options. All color options are available on this shape.

This color chart represents the approximate shades of TYGAR CurbColors™
Please use this chart as a guide only.



Mixing Instructions: Portland cement only (47 pounds per sack) add:

• 1 Bag of color for a 2% load • 2 Bags of color for a 4% load

This chart should be used as a guide only, and we suggest that samples be made before determining color choice. These colors may not represent the final color, as shade variations can be influenced by a number of factors, including the sand, water, cement, etc. used in the mix, as well as other external factors.




Mower's Edge Shape




